Established in 1998 and operating as a public legal entity under The Center for Legal Examination and Legislative Initiatives since 2022, the Institute of Law and Human Rights (the Institute) aims to carry out legal awareness activities, as well as the analysis and expert examination of draft legislation.



EXPERT EXAMINATION, ANALYSIS, OPINIONS, AND PROPOSALS

- ◆ Expert examination of **6** draft normative legal acts;
- ◆ Analysis of **6** normative legal acts;
- ◆ Preparation of **7** proposals based on the decisions of the European Court of Human Rights (ECHR).
- ◆ Translation of **6** international treaties.



EVENTS, TRAININGS, AND PRESENTATIONS

The Institute conducted 35 events and presentations on topics including “International Human Rights Day,” “Heydar Aliyev: Combating Crime,” the discussion of the “Second Monitoring Report on Journals Publishing Legal Articles,” “Digital Initiatives in the Field of Human Rights,” and others.

14 trainings were conducted for the general public on such topics as “Guarantees of Fundamental Human Rights and Freedoms in the Constitution of the Republic of Azerbaijan,” “Social Behavior: Police and Youth,” “Protection of Property Rights and the European Convention on Human Rights,” “Protection of Children’s Rights” and others.

11 trainings were conducted for employees of state institutions (the Ministry of Internal Affairs, prosecutorial authorities, courts, the Ministry of Justice, the Bar Association, etc.) on such topics as “Ensuring the Rights and Freedoms of Persons Held in Places of Detention,” “Protection of Property Rights and Local Executive Authorities,” “Human Rights and the Environment,” “Artificial Intelligence and Human Rights” and others.

Employees of the Institute participated in 43 conferences, roundtables, seminars, presentations, and webinars held at both national and international levels.



Enrichment of the Legal Journals Search Database with 58 journal issues and 359 academic articles.

Uploading of 93 legal articles to the Audio Articles Database.

Addition of 74 new legal terms to the Explanatory E-Dictionary on Human Rights.

Submission of 46 proposals through the PASS Platform (Practical Application Signals Survey) aimed at improving the implementation of legislation.

Update of the Digital Human Rights Resources Map, consolidating contact information of various institutions and organizations across 74 cities and districts.



PUBLICATIONS AND ARTICLES, MONITORING REPORTS, SCIENTIFIC ACTIVITIES OF EMPLOYEES

- ◆ The book “The Victorious Path of Sovereignty: Realized Ideas, Legal Grounds, Political Parallels” was published, and its presentation was organized at 19 higher education institutions, 2 research centers of the Azerbaijan National Academy of Sciences (ANAS), and the Constitutional Court. Overall, 22 presentations were held, with the participation of 250 researchers and academic staff, 1,172 students, 41 court employees, 10 lawyers, and media representatives.
- ◆ Publication of the “Legal Terms Dictionary,” covering explanatory definitions of more than 3,500 legal terms.
- ◆ Publication of the “Academic Legal Writing Guidebook”.
- ◆ Preparation of 3 monitoring reports (1 report on legal journals and 2 reports on violations of human rights in online media).
- ◆ 42 articles and 6 interviews by the Institute staff members were published in newspapers, academic journals, and online platforms.



During the year, cooperation was established with 69 state institutions and educational organizations.



LIBRARY FUND AND VIRTUAL LIBRARY

- ◆ 183 new legal publications were added to the Institute’s library fund, bringing the total number to 3,675. Additionally, 1,409 books published by the Institute were presented to the readers.
- ◆ 502 legal publications were uploaded to the Virtual Library. Currently, the Virtual Library contains 2,211 publications covering various fields of law.
- ◆ 336,394 active user downloads from the Virtual Library were recorded. In total, between 10 May 2023 to 26 December 2025, 892,719 downloads were made by users.
