LEGAL EXAMINATION, ANALYSIS, OPINIONS, AND PROPOSALS

- ◉ Preparation of scientific-practical commentary on the Law of the Republic of Azerbaijan on "Ensuring the Rights and Freedoms of Individuals Held in Detention Facilities."
- ◉ Examination of 5 draft normative legal acts.
- ◉ Analysis of 6 normative legal acts.
- ◉ Preparation of 20 proposals regarding decisions of the European Court of Human Rights (ECHR).
- ◉ Translation of 13 legal documents.



EVENTS, TRAININGS, AND PRESENTATIONS

DIGITAL RESOURCES AND INITIATIVES

"Digital Human Rights Resources Map": includes contact information for organizations across 74 cities and regions.

The Search Databases which include information about 101 legal scholars, 363 journal issues, and 980 articles were created.

Audio Articles Database: Offers 55 legal articles in audio format, available on the Institute's website.

E-vocabulary on Human Rights: Includes definitions for 50 terms.

PASS Platform (Practical Signal Inquiry Platform) : 22 proposals aimed at improving the application of legislation were submitted by the platform users.

Human Rights Trainer Database containing information on 18 trainers specialized in human rights was created. 85 people benefited from the virtual human rights course established in 2023.

- ⦿ The book "Heydar Aliyev: Fighting Crime" was published.
- ⦿ 3 monitoring reports on topic "Violations of Human Rights in Online Media" were prepared.
- ⦿ "Fact Sheet on Raising the International Ranking of Scholars" was published. "Guidelines for Preparing Academic Articles in Law" was developed.
- ⦿ 32 articles, 7 theses, and 5 interviews across various platforms were published.
- ⦿ Employees of the Institute participated in 32 events, including conferences and webinars, and were awarded with 30 certificates following training sessions conducted at both local and international levels.
